Council Member Barbra Williamson was successful in her first election bid to the City Council in November 1992, and was re-elected in 1996, 2000, and for a fourth term in 2004. She served as Mayor Pro Tem in 1997 and 2000 and was appointed Mayor Pro Tem again for another one-year term in 2005. Council Member Williamson co-chairs the Task Force on Homelessness, which was formed by the City Council in 1999 to develop strategies to address homelessness in Simi Valley.

Council Member Williamson serves on the Simi Valley Arts Commission and the Arroyo Simi Ad Hoc Committee. She is also a member of the Los Angeles Avenue Revitalization Committee and the Tapo Street Revitalization Committee. These committees were established to work with business and property owners interested in rejuvenating commercial areas to improve business potential as well as community aesthetics. In addition, she serves as the City representative to the Ventura County Transportation Commission, a regional transportation planning board, and serves on the Ventura County Animal Regulation Commission.

Simi Valley has been Council Member Williamson's home for over 30 years. She is Vice President/Business Development at First California Bank.
