Mayor Pro Tem Michelle Foster was appointed to the City Council on December 13, 2004, and was successful in her election bid for a four-year term in November 2006.

Mayor Pro Tem Foster is the owner of PrintMasters, a commercial printing business. She has served as a Director on the Simi Valley Chamber of Commerce Board and is a graduate of the Chamber's Leadership Simi Valley Program.
